

Let's Go – Summary for Lereko & Greg

This is a Word for His Body: the church, His covenant people.

"I hear the Lord say He is getting ready to hand out big assignments at this time. To mark out new allotments (allocations/distributions) of territory to His people. These are assignments to take new territory or new ground for His Kingdom. I hear the Lord say that these are extensive allotments, vast areas of territory the extent and range of which are larger than what we anticipated, expected or even imagined. Yes, these are big visions, the kind that will cause our natural man to cower in fear and shrink back at their size, but the Lord is calling His people to a strong and courageous faith now - a Joshua type faith - as He gets ready to move us into vast new territories that lie beyond our existing borders and that which we currently know."

This word is directional with a call to action:

a) Direction:

- He has mapped out vast new territory for us to take for His kingdom
- So we can expect new assignments in this season
- They are significant in size – vast – & new - beyond what we now have

b) Call to action:

- Calls us to increased levels of faith – Caleb & Joshua type faith.
- To awareness of our natural responses, those things that will challenge our faith and must be overcome in order to give Him full obedience in responding to His word.
- Natural responses =:
 - "fear & shrinking back" at the size of the assignment.
 - For some these assignments will be unexpected.
 - For some these assignments will be unanticipated.

c) Full word is on the website: What is my response?

- Take the word praying.
- Stir up faith.
- Be doers of the word and not only hearers.
- Proceed with wisdom & revelation (don't run with every assignment you meet now...)

I see that for some these new assignments will be unexpected. These are those who have already successfully taken territory, possess it and dwell in it. They have been faithfully working their talents for many years now and feel that it is 'late in the day' as if their job is nearly done but the Lord is getting ready to assign further territory to these, He is getting ready to stretch and extend your borders beyond what you already know and currently have. I hear Him say, "to everyone who has more will be given..." (Mat 25:29).

I see that for others these new assignments will be unanticipated. These feel unqualified, as if they could not possibly be chosen to do something of this magnitude and importance for the Kingdom. I hear the Lord say to these, 'no eye has seen, nor ear heard, nor the heart of man imagined, what God has prepared for those who love Him' (1 Cor 2:9). I hear also the words 'hand swop' and see that just as Jacob placed unlikely Ephraim before obvious Manasseh when he crossed his hands and bestowed on Ephraim (the youngest son) the right hand of blessing traditionally reserved and given only to the firstborn son (Manasseh) (Genesis 48), so too I see that there will be some 'hand swop' assignments and callings given in this time. God is getting ready to give new assignments to the unlikely and less obvious in this season as He brings many out of the shadows of obscurity and calls them to lead and participate in significant new works.

In this season the Lord is calling for a Caleb response from His people; the faith response that says, 'let's go' at once for we are well able to overcome (Numbers 13:30). He is looking for those who will not shrink back at the size of the assignment; for men and women like Joshua and Caleb who by faith will keep Him bigger than the vision He will set before them. I hear the Spirit of God calling His bride to a strong and courageous faith in this season - a very courageous faith - and I hear the Lord say, "Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go." (Joshua 1:9)

I see that this is a continuation of His previous word given to us on the 27 August 2018 titled "Get Ready". I hear Him say that we have been in a time of preparation, a time in which He called 'His bride to make herself ready' and that this period of preparation was to make us ready for the commissioning and sending that will now follow. I sense that what He is getting ready to do through His Body on the earth in this coming season is of similar significance and magnitude to when Israel crossed over the Jordan to begin their campaign of taking vast territory, driving out all opposition and subduing the land. I do not see it all but I cannot escape the overriding sense that what the Lord is getting ready to do with us now is on a great scale and of tremendous magnitude.

Preamble:

When Israel conquered Canaan the land was divided up between the 12 tribes by lot. Each tribe received an 'allotment' which was an area of land marking out the extent and range of their territory with its borders, cities and villages. These allotments of land signified inheritance.

Hebrews 11:8: **By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go** out to the place which he would receive as an inheritance. **And he went** out, not knowing where he was going.
